

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS: DURHAM
STANDARD REMARK E87

THE SUPPLIER IS REQUIRED TO FOLLOW THE PROCEDURES SET FORTH BELOW REGARDING MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEETS (MSDS).

1. MSDS SHALL BE SUPPLIED PRIOR TO ESTABLISHING TRANSACTIONS FOR "NEW" CHEMICALS (I.E., HAVE NOT BEEN BROUGHT ON THE FACILITY) AND CURRENT/UPDATED MSDS, AS THEY BECOME AVAILABLE, PRIOR TO SHIPMENT.
2. PROVIDE CHEMICALS IN EITHER RETURNABLE OR RECYCLABLE CONTAINERS. RETURNABLE CONTAINERS ARE PREFERRED.
3. MAINTAIN A RUNNING INVENTORY OF CHEMICALS BROUGHT ON SITE, BROKEN OUT BY CHEMICAL AND DATE OF ENTRY ON SITE.
4. TRACK AND MAINTAIN RECORDS OF MATERIALS WHICH ARE, OR CONTAIN, EPCRA (SARA) 313 REPORTABLE CHEMICALS.
5. SUPPLY WARNING LABELS FROM MANUFACTURER, WHERE POSSIBLE ON SECONDARY CONTAINERS.
6. ADHERE TO ATTACHED PACKAGING CRITERIA.
