NORTH AMERICAN FREE TRADE AGREEMENT (NAFTA)

SUPPLIER WILL ADVISE PURCHASER OF THE COUNTRY OF ORIGIN OF ANY GOODS DELIVERED TO PURCHASER, AND WHETHER THE GOODS ORIGINATE IN THE NAFTA REGION (AS DEFINED IN SECTION 401 OF THE NAFTA). IF THE GOODS ORIGINATE IN THE NAFTA REGION, SUPPLIER AGREES TO PROVIDE A NAFTA CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN COVERING THE GOODS. SUPPLIERS WHICH PROVIDE A CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN WILL MAINTAIN SUPPORTING RECORDS FOR FIVE YEARS, AND WILL NOTIFY PURCHASER OF ANY SUBSEQUENT CHANGES WHICH COULD AFFECT THE ACCURACY OR VALIDITY OF THE CERTIFICATES. SUPPLIER ALSO AGREES TO COOPERATE FULLY IN ANY PROCEEDINGS BY ANY GOVERNMENT TO VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF ANY CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN PROVIDED TO PURCHASER, AND SUPPLIER WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF ERRONEOUS INFORMATION PROVIDED TO PURCHASER REGARDING THE ORIGIN OF THE GOODS.
